REVOLVING LOAN FUND PLAN CDBG Economic Development Program Plan

The City of Shelby has available Program Income as part of the Community Development Block Grant Program from the Montana Department of Commerce (MDOC).

ORGANIZATIONAL MISSION To an address a syderical minimum and an address to the state of the stat

The City of Shelby Revolving Loan Fund (RLF) is designed to stimulate economic development activity by assisting the private sector, in order to retain jobs and provide working capital for eligible businesses. These funds will be used in situations where a funding gap exists and alternative sources of public and private financing are not adequate.

The RLF is designed to assist businesses by making appropriate long-term, fixed rate financing available to them at reasonable interest loan rates and grants, and by providing public improvements in support of economic development activities.

PROGRAM OBJECTIVE

The objective of the Revolving Loan Fund (RLF) will be to continue the activities from which the program income is being derived, specifically:

 Retain employment opportunities, to benefit no less than 51% Low and Moderate Income (LMI) persons within the City of Shelby, which is the designated RLF Assistance area; and

I. ELIGIBLE APPLICANTS

Eligible applicants requesting loan assistance will be restricted to for-profit businesses within the designated RLF Assistance Area. The RLF Assistance Area is defined as being within the Shelby. Applicant must also have an active city business license.

MAXIMUM LOAN AMOUNT

The maximum loan amount is \$10,000 and a minimum of \$2,500 dependent on the type of financing requested and needs of individual businesses.

ELIGIBLE ACTIVITIES

Eligible activities include support of economic development as a means of job retention and working capital.

Use of program income must be consistent with eligible activities as determined by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (24 CFR Part 570.201 or Section 105(a) of Title I of the Housing and Community Development Act) and the Montana DOC Community Development Block Grant Program.

1. CDBG Project Participation

The City may use program income to participate in support of economic development projects within Shelby as a means of job retention and working capital for eligible businesses.

TYPES OF FINANCING AVAILABLE

Business Direct Loans

Eligible applicants may apply for assistance to finance predetermined and documented business retention and/or expansion of activities in an effort to retain jobs. Loan proceeds may be used for the following activities:

- payroll
- working capital to include, but not limited to rent/lease; utilities; cost of goods sold/inventory and other costs associated with day-to-day operations

APPLICATION PROCEDURES

The Revolving Loan Fund Committee will accept loan applications on an open-cycle basis. The application deadline will be 5:00 p.m. the last working day of any week. Completed loan applications may be mailed or delivered to Shelby Finance Officer Jade Goroski. (See application form - Attachment A)

Applicants should use the application summary and attach all required information. In addition, the for-profit business or nonprofit entity should complete the Business Application Requirements section of the guidelines.

Applications will be reviewed and analyzed by the committee on a "first come, first served" basis, as determined by the date of the full application is found to be complete by the City of Shelby.

LOAN REVIEW PROCESS

Loan applications will receive a preliminary review by the Loan Review Committee to determine completeness of each application. Only complete applications will be advanced to the formal review process.

The loan review committee is comprised of City of Shelby Loan Committee members who at present consist of one banking representative, one business representative and one city representative. This makeup allows for replacement by appointment from the City of Shelby.

The Committee will review each application for compliance with program objectives.

Each application will be evaluated separately on a first-come first-served basis. Should requests for funds exceed funds available, applications that are deemed to represent a likelihood of broadest impact will receive the most favorable review.

LOAN TERMS

Approved loans will have a zero-interest rate with a 12-month deferral. This agreement will expire at the end of 12 months from the date of this agreement or at an earlier time if agreed upon in writing by both parties. Should the business be sold or close within 12 months of this agreement, 100% of this loan will be paid back. If the business continues to retain employees for the purpose of doing business, this loan will become a grant at the end of the 12 months.

Ranking of Applications

Each Revolving Loan Fund application for assistance will be ranked in the following categories. A best ranking will equal 5 points, an average ranking will equal 3 points, and a poor ranking will equal 1 point. Any application receiving less than a poor score in a category is ineligible for the benefits of this program and will be rejected.

1. Business proposal is appropriate for the city and this program.

Best = 5 points

Average = 3 points

Poor = 1 point

2. Percent benefit to Low- and Moderate-Income Persons

Bes = 5 points

Average = 3 points

Poor = 1 point

Within 5 days from the application deadline, the Committee will provide the Mayor with a written evaluation of each loan application, accompanied with a recommendation for loan approval or rejection. The Mayor has Council approval to approve or reject loan applications. The City Council will be kept informed on a bimonthly basis of loan approvals or rejections.

II. ANNUAL REPORT

As required by the Montana Department of Commerce, an annual report of Revolving Loan Fund activities will be submitted to the Community Development Block Grant – Economic Development Program along with a proposed budget for the following year.

AMENDMENTS TO THE ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT REVOLVING LOAN FUND GUIDELINES

The City of Shelby may amend these guidelines by a majority vote of the City of Shelby and approved by the Montana Department of Commerce. Amendments will be incorporated into a revised statement of the CDBG Economic Development Program Income Revolving Loan Fund Guidelines.

On April 9, 2020, the City of Shelby, Montana received notice from the Montana Department of Commerce that the Shelby, Montana application for economic development under the Montana Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program has been tentatively approved.

Pursuant to this notification, it is the finding of the City of Shelby that all of the following project activities approved for funding under the State-administered CDBG Program are defined as "exempt" under 24 CFR Part 58.34, and meets the conditions specified therein for such exemption, of the Environmental Review Procedures for the Title I CDBG Program, and that the costs associated with conducting these activities are defined as reimbursable under 24 CFR Part 570.200(h) of the CDBG Regulations:

> Support of economic development as a means of job retention and working capital for eligible businesses through the City of Shelby CDBG Program Income Revolving Loan Fund.

CITY OF SHELBY PROGRAM INCOME PLAN

Master Plan for CDBG & HOME Programs

Description

The City of Shelby administered housing programs: M99-SG3001-41; M03-SG3001-41; and M06-SG3001-41 between 1999 and 2006. The programs were funded through grants from the Montana Department of Commerce Community Development Block Grant Housing Program as well as the HOME Program. Funds may be captured along with a share of the appreciation of the property and returned to the City of Shelby when the title changes due to the sale of the home, foreclosure or refinance of the original borrower as per the Restriction Agreement and Promissory Note agreed upon by the City and program participant. If funds are recaptured from a previously assisted property, the resulting funds are referred to as Program Income. This Program Income must be used in compliance with CDBG requirements, as applicable.

The City of Shelby wishes to retain this Program Income and use it as a source of funds for new development and rehabilitation opportunities for income eligible recipients and eligible community public facility projects as well as support for economic development which included job retention, job training, job creation and working capital for eligible businesses. HOME program income funds recaptured from homebuyer assistance programs will be used for HOME-eligible activities (rental construction, housing rehabilitation and homebuyer assistance) for low-income households. CDBG program income funds will be spent in support of housing development; rehabilitation efforts; and eligible public facility projects within the City of Shelby. It will also support economic development as a means for job retention and working capital for eligible businesses. Loan terms – interest rates, duration and potential for deferral will be established based on current economic conditions and financial need as part of economic development projects to eligible businesses.

Program Income received will be recorded in the City of Shelby Revolving Loan Fund and will be invested in CDBG eligible activities in a timely manner.

The City of Shelby Finance Officer will provide activity reports to the Shelby City Council as needed and activity will be reported in audited financial statements. The City of Shelby will provide, at any reasonable time, MDOC, Comptroller General of the United States, Montana Legislative Auditor or their authorized agents access to any records necessary to determine ongoing compliance.

Financial Reporting

The City of Shelby completes annual audits under the provisions of the U.S. Office of Management and Budget Uniform Guidance.

The City of Shelby utilizes the BARS system for accounting purposes, with the Finance Officer overseeing entering of transactions, preparation of warrants and disbursements. City staff are responsible for processing receipts, disbursements, ensuring all transactions are properly authorized, generating reports and budget review documents, and preparing reports to funding sources.

Expiration of Program Income Plan Agreement

This agreement will expire twenty (20) years plus five (5) years from the signature date. If at any time, the terms and conditions of this agreement change, this agreement must be amended to reflect the changes.
