WEED ORDINANCE - MOW NOTICE

As spring turns into summer, weeds and debris can get unsightly! The City of Shelby weed ordinance requires all vegetation on property be kept below six inches. If vegetation is in excess of this, you are in violation of the ordinance and the city can go in and mow your property – billing you for the time! The ordinance can be found on the City of Shelby website at (www.shelbymt.com).

At the same time, trees, hedges and bushes at intersections must be no higher than 2 1/2 feet within 30 feet of the street corner for visibility and safety of pedestrians and motorists. Please look at your property, be a good neighbor and let's make our community shine this summer. Your efforts are greatly appreciated.
