- 3. While the Council is in session, those in attendance must preserve order and decorum. No member of the public shall delay or interrupt the Council proceedings; disturb any member who may be speaking; or refuse to obey the orders of the Council or its presiding officer.
- 4. Prepared statements are welcome and should be given to the Finance Officer prior to a Council meeting. Prepared statements that are also read, however, shall be deemed unduly repetitious. All prepared statements for public hearings shall become part of the hearing record.
- 5. All remarks shall be addressed to the Council as a body and not to any member of the Council or Staff.
- 6. Public members recognized by the presiding officer, shall:
  - a. Stand, if able
  - b. For the record, give his/her name and address
  - c. If applicable, give the person, firm or organization he/she represents
  - d. Limit comments to the matter of fact
  - e. Address the Council as a body and not to any individual member of the Council or City Staff
  - f. Ask no questions of individuals who are Council members, staff or other public members, except through the presiding officer
  - g. Limit comments to a maximum of 5 minutes, unless such time is extended by a majority vote of Council members.

**ORDINANCE NO. 859** 

BE IT ORDAINED, that the following section be added to Title 5, Chapter 1, of the City Code

of Shelby, Montana:

5-1-7 URBAN CAMPING:

A.

1. Unless otherwise provided in this Section, it shall constitute a misdemeanor offense for a

person to camp on City property or any public right-of-way for a period of more than

forty-eight (48) consecutive hours.

2. This Section does not apply to lawfully permitted campers at Lake Shel-oole and

Williamson Park campgrounds who pay the required fees.

3. The act of moving a campsite from one location on City property or a public right of way

to another location on City property or a public right of way shall not stop the forty-eight

(48) hour period necessary to be found guilty under this Section from running.

1. The following definitions apply to this Section:

CAMP: to inhabit a location as one's place of permanent or temporary residence without

any means of shelter or with any of the following means of shelter:

-a tent

- a vehicle

-a box, a tarp, or other similar rudimentary forms of shelter

CAMPSITE: the location where one camps

VEHICLE: every device in or upon which any person or property is or may be transported or drawn upon a street or thoroughfare, except devices moved by human or animal power or used exclusively upon stationary rails or tracks

Effective November 20th, 2025.

## **RESOLUTION NO. 2136**
