- 4. Prepared statements are welcome and should be given to the Finance Officer prior to a Council meeting. Prepared statements that are also read, however, shall be deemed unduly repetitious. All prepared statements for public hearings shall become part of the hearing record.
- 5. All remarks shall be addressed to the Council as a body and not to any member of the Council or Staff.
- 6. Public members recognized by the presiding officer, shall:
 - a. Stand, if able
 - b. For the record, give his/her name and address
 - c. If applicable, give the person, firm or organization he/she represents
 - d. Limit comments to the matter of fact
 - e. Address the Council as a body and not to any individual member of the Council or City Staff
 - f. Ask no questions of individuals who are Council members, staff or other public members, except through the presiding officer
 - g. Limit comments to a maximum of 5 minutes, unless such time is extended by a majority vote of Council members.

MINUTES OF THE PARK & RECREATION COMMITTEE

October 26, 2021

In attendance: Pat Frydenlund, Lyle Kimmet, Jessi LaTray, Eric Tokerud and Lorette Carter, reporting.

Civic Center:

Jessi reported she is offering a November special. When people take part in 10 or more fall classes, they will be entered into a drawing for a class pass which is good for 10 classes. She is also planning a Fun-Fitness-Fair the first Saturday in December. Class instructors will offer 30-minute demonstrations and North Town Drug will offer smoothie samples. Also on the calendar is the Rib Tickler which is scheduled for October 20th and Logan Health has secured the facility for an event, November 15th.

In regard to maintenance, Jessi talked about new stalls for the men's locker room; new countertops and sinks in both bathrooms and stair treads for the stairs to the elliptical and treadmill rooms. She will work with Rob, city building inspector and handyman when he returns to work. Ideas were also discussed in moving some equipment down to a racquetball court for those of limited mobility.

City Facilities:

Roadrunner Recreation Trail/Mountain Bike Trail: The mountain bike trail has been completed. Bo Trails of Bozeman completed a little over 3 miles, rather than 5 miles as some areas originally marked would be too wet in the spring or not suitable for mountain biking. Pat Frydenlund suggested we create signage for not only the trail head, but also in the Lake Shel-oole Campground where the trail is accessible at the north end. Lorette will also ask city personnel to mow around that area so the trail is visible. The next step is creating a name for the trail, signage and a brochure.

Krysko Skate Park: Lorette reported the Kiwanis presented a check to the city from the Kiwanis fundraiser in the amount of \$1,290.00. The funds will be used for a picnic table and trash receptacles. The city will wait to hear on the Land Water Conservation Fund Grant application before placing an order for these items. The city still has to paint the yellow at the ADA ramp on the Main Street sidewalk. Lorette will also follow up with city personnel again on striping the basketball hoops.

Swimming Pool: The pool is drained and the city is waiting on a bid for a new boiler system in anticipation of next summer. Eric suggested the city reach out to Lexy to ensure her of the improvements to be made before next summer and hope she will return next summer as pool manager.

Shelby Park System: City park irrigation systems are blown out in anticipation of winter. Lorette is working on the "Adopt A Park" program suggested by Councilman Joe Flesch for next spring.

Historic Shelby High: Work continues on the gym. The sheet rocking is complete and stairs carved into the stage area. Future plans are to make the locker rooms accessible and refinish the gym floor. The east door has been rekeyed and a facility use agreement is in place for all those using the facility.

Champions Park: The lighting of the bollards in Champions Park has been completed. The city is waiting on MRE to install a meter to begin luminating the park in the evenings. Champions Park Committee members are continuing work on the homesteader field stones to complete the base of the Champions Park monument sign. They are having difficulty securing someone to complete the masonry.

Fall Clean Up Week: The city's annual fall cleanup is this week, October 25th. Residents were able to call the city shop to have items placed on the pickup list. Fridges, freezers, air conditioners and tires cannot be picked up as there are associated disposal costs and the fridges, freezers and air conditioners require Freon removal.

Tree Board:

Fall Tree Care Workshop: The Fall Tree Care Workshop was October 14th. Two families were in attendance.

MUFCA: Lorette reported the MUCFA ~ Montana Urban & Community Forestry Association has scheduled the removal of 6 aging Bitterroot School trees. New trees will be purchased for planting in other areas of the community through the Arbor Day and Urban Forestry grants. She is also researching the costs of conducting a city tree inventory. The city had public trees inventoried in 2005 and 2014.

New Business:

MT Office of Tourism Survey: Lorette distributed the Office of Tourism survey postcard to gather resident and non-resident thoughts on things Shelby is doing right and what we need to improve. Lorette also showed the MT Office of Tourism poster which features the Shelby Carousel.

Shelby Brochure: Lorette handed out the new Shelby brochure financed by the Shelby Tourism Business Improvement District. The brochure is distributed throughout the Great Falls region through Certified Folder Display Services in hotels, restaurants and other tourism locations.

Re: Shelby water line extension project benefits

Department Officials,

With the region facing a declining population and employment rate high, the city sought to provide regional benefit in creating economic diversification, providing greater resilience for communities and a broader array of opportunities for individuals seeking employment within our Golden Triangle area of northern Montana.

In approximately 2015, Humic Growth Solutions, a company that manufactures a product to improve farm soil conditions began working with the City to locate a plant here. The plant would provide many good jobs, taxes, and other much needed economic benefit to the area. In its manufacturing process, Humic requires substantial amounts of water from a reliable source. The City of Shelby applied for and was funded CDBG-ED grant funds for the extension of City water lines to Humic Growth Solutions.

Once it was completed, the water extension line project had a profound impact on the water capacity at Humic Growth Solutions. The original undersized 3" line was not adequate to meet the 25,000-gallon tank volume needed to operate the "wet chemistry" production plant at capacity and allow for additional shift work to meet production demands. At the same time, the single pump was unreliable and not sufficient to meet water needs. The new 8" line now provides adequate water pressure to reduce the time to fill the operation tank and the new pump system has redundant pumping capacity in which to provide adequate pressure to pump the water up the hill.

As an added benefit, the new pump and lines upgraded existing infrastructure that supplied users outside of the City's limits. The new system provides a clean, safe connection for rural households and agricultural operations along Highway 2 east. The Homesteader Hill rural subdivision of 6 households (16-18 individuals) previously had a non-compliant and inefficient system installed over 50 years ago. Households were consistently threatened with insufficient water pressure. There were numerous breaks in the line and there was inadequate fireflow,

threatening the safety and wellbeing of individuals and property. The water extension project allowed the Homesteader Hill households to connect at the Humic Growth juncture to the new water line, providing clean, safe water for consumption and fireflow.

Critical to future water distribution along the northern tier of central Montana, the City of Shelby is currently the regional hub for the North Central Regional Water Authority. As the interim water supplier, we were able to assist the Devon Water District in connecting to a safe, clean water system. Waiting for eventual connection to the North Central Montana Regional Water system and faced with non-compliance with the Department of Environmental Quality water standards, the 27 farming operations and Devon residents (98 residents) sought assistance from the City of Shelby to bring water to households, animal barns and farming operations east of Shelby. These commercial farming operations account for thousands of acres of Montana wheat, barley and other agricultural commodities.

According to Devon Water District operator, Roy Benjamin the water system provides water not only to households, but also supplies water to spray over 129,000 acres of prime farmland. He noted the herbicides, pesticides and micronutrient applications used by most producers requires 10-20 gallons per acre and is applied several times per year. He also estimated the average producer invests at least \$200 per acre in growing crop. He estimated the Devon water user base contributes an estimated \$26 million to the local economy, as well as over \$1 million in real estate and personal property tax assessments. These contributions are a direct result of the value of the farm and ranch product being produced, which is impossible without water. He went on to reiterate the \$26 million worth of crops and many millions in structures and livestock which are now protected from fires by the fast access to the Shelby-Devon transmission line hydrants and public standpipe.

Lastly, Mr. Benjamin noted the water line also serves the Frontier Supper Club, a bar/restaurant located approximately 10 miles east of Shelby. The supper club serves hundreds of area residents and travelers weekly in their dining/after-hours establishment.

Most recently, the City was approached by a local developer planning a housing development east of Shelby. The project is currently in the DEQ review stages. This development would not be possible if not for the upgraded line size and pumping capability the water line extension provided.

As Mr. Benjamin stated in his email... "We REALLY, REALLY appreciate the Shelby water supply!"
