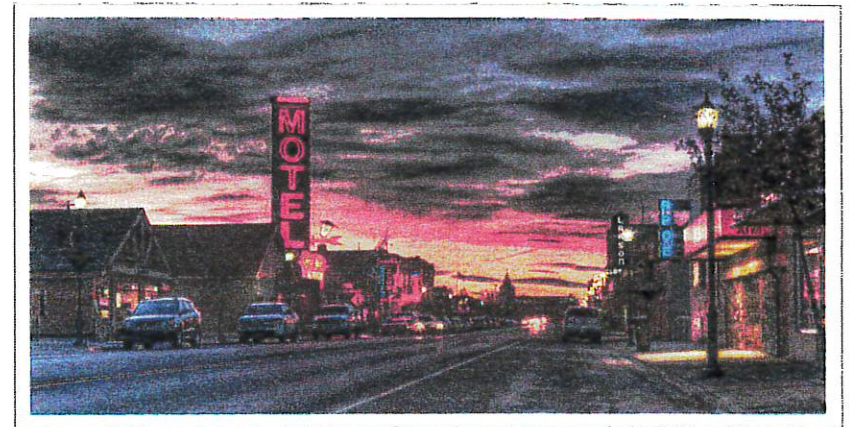

Lake Shel-oole~ Fishing

Flood waters ravaged Shelby's north side in 1964 and 1965 when days of drenching rain burst the Sullivan Dam. This watershed project was completed in 1969 with MT Fish Wildlife & Parks stocking the reservoir for fun, family fishing.

Lake Shel-oole has an abundance of perch and some trout which can be fished from the floating dock or along the shoreline. Birds and water fowl are abundant on the reservoir during spring and summer months and many enjoy ice fishing in the cold, winter months.

Roadrunner Recreation Trail

The trail begins at the intersection of Main Street and Coyote Pass. The trail heads north on the bike path along Oilfield Avenue approximately 1.3 miles where it leaves Oilfield at North Lake Shel-ooole Drive and circumvents Lake Shel-ooole for approximately 2.6 miles. The trail joins the City Shop Road, continuing into Shelby on Galena Avenue and back to Main Street. A mid-way loop joins North Park Drive about .50 miles from the City Shop Road. The Roadrunner Recreation Trail is 5.06 miles paved asphalt with varied degrees of difficulty. The trail provides wonderful views of the Rocky Mountains and Sweetgrass Hills; takes you right through the natural prairies of northern Montana and provides great exercise and a lot of fun.
