

RESOLUTION NO. 1937

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SHELBY,
MONTANA, CONCERNING RESIDENTIAL WATER TAPS ON
TRAVIS AND BETH COLLIER'S PROPERTY**

WHEREAS, Travis and Beth Collier have agreed to execute easements to the North Central Montana Regional Water Authority (NCMRWA) for the new water line being constructed in Toole County, Montana, and

WHEREAS, the City of Shelby will maintain and operate the above water lines, and

WHEREAS, the City of Shelby provides a water tap at 415 Marias Valley Road at the rate of \$65.00 per month, and the City of Shelby has agreed to hook the residence up to both water lines and replace their water service line from the main up to their distribution box, and

WHEREAS, the City of Shelby has agreed to provide one residential water tap capable of providing 2 gallons per minute on any tract of land, which is of record, which is owned by Travis and/or Beth Collier, at the flat rate of \$65.00 per month in addition to the current water service at 415 Marias Valley Road.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Shelby, Montana as follows:

That the City of Shelby agrees to provide a water tap at the property owned by Travis and Beth Collier at 415 Marias Valley Road at the flat rate of \$65.00 per month as operator of the water line owned by the NCMRWA and maintained and operated by the City of Shelby, and the City of Shelby shall provide one residential water tap capable of providing 2 gallons per minute on any tract of land which is of record and is owned by Travis and/or Beth Collier, at the flat rate of \$65.00 per month in addition to the current water service at 415 Marias Valley Road. The City of Shelby will hook the residence up to both water lines and replace their water service line from the main up to their distribution box.
